

MOW COP METHODIST CHAPEL OPEN DAYS

The Methodist Chapel on Primitive Street, Mow Cop will be open this year as part of the 'Congleton Heritage and Antiques Festival' on three Sunday afternoons: September 9th, 16th, and 23rd, from 2.00-4.30 pm with the theme 'William Clowes- A Burning and Shining Light'.

A guided tour of the chapel will be linked with different experiences within the life of the venerable William Clowes - one of the most significant founders of the Primitive Methodist movement from 1807.

This year there will be virtual reality flames in the pulpit, the Magic Lantern with late Victorian glass slides will be used, and light refreshments will be served.

Mow Cop Methodist Chapel is situated on Primitive Street, Mow Cop ST7 3NW (very close to the border of Cheshire and Staffordshire, and a short walk from the National Trust 'Castle' landmark).
